The products directly connect to the Cresnet bus and are programmed in SIMPL Windows. All were tested and validated by Crestron as part of their Integrated Partner Program.

Deseo available soon

Basalte also announces that its Deseo temperature controller starts shipping very soon. The touch-sensitive Deseo has a 1.7" OLED screen so you can intuitively control the set point, fan speed and temperature modes. Through multitouch, you can also quickly turn the lights on/off by using a welcome/goodbye scene. The integrated temperature sensor reports the room temperature to the Crestron system.
